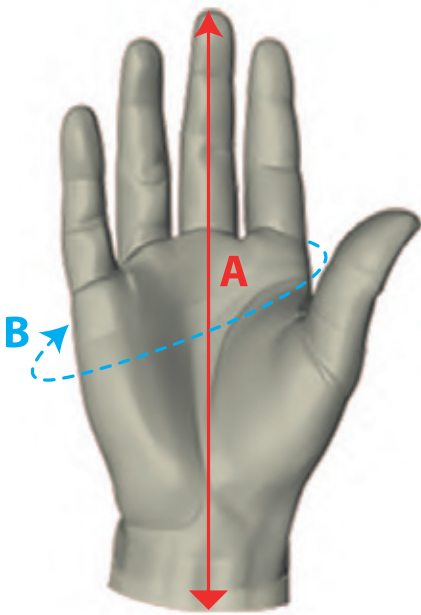


STARLINE KNOW YOUR SIZE!

How can you choose the size that suits you when using gloves?

It is very important to use suitable size of gloves for extra comfort and convenience during use. To determine the size of a glove, it is necessary to consider the periphery of the hand and the length of the fingers. In this direction, you can learn the size of your hand by using of the tables and drawings prepared for you below.









A / Length: Keep your palm open as shown in the figure and measure the length of your hand by extending the tape measure from the top of your middle finger to the end of your palm on a straight line.

B / Hand Periphery: Keep your palm open as shown and measure your hand periphery by placing the tape measure between your thumb and forefinger and by wrapping it as shown in the figure.

With the value you measure in centimeters, you can learn the glove size that suits you from the size chart below. If your measurements are between 2 sizes, you need to choose the larger size.



STARLINE wristband gloves are produced by sewing color bands to represent the sizes they belong to.

(*): This code is a representation of the hand size corresponding to the hand periphery expressed in inches. 1 inch: 2.54cm.

WARNING: Measuring hands in this way does not correspond to all possible alternatives in hand size. For instance, If a user's fingers are longer or shorter than the average, the hand size appearing in the table will not give the appropriate glove size to the person. In this case, larger or smaller gloves may fit more comfortably in the hand.
